

Container Transport cannot transport any items classified as Dangerous Goods under the NZTA Land Transport Rule: Dangerous Goods 2005.

Dangerous Goods are items with explosive, flammable, toxic, infectious, corrosive, or environmentally hazardous properties. These items are usually marked with a diamond-shaped warning label showing their hazard class.



Some examples of common household items classed as Dangerous Goods, are:



Cleaning Chemicals



Fireworks



Gas Bottles



Aerosol cans



Lithium Batteries



Fire Extinguishers



Scuba tanks



Petrol



Ammunition



Spa or Pool Chlorine



Methylated Spirits



Matches



Pesticides & Garden Chemicals

Please remove any dangerous goods from your inventory and arrange alternative transport for them. Also ensure all organic matter - such as perishable foods, compost, animal skins, or any items that may rot or emit odor - is excluded
