



Service Overview

This option pairs a live load at one end with a ground placement at the other. We collect using a flatdeck truck, with the container staying on the deck the whole time while it's loaded – no lifting equipment needed, and no large clear area required, so it works well in narrow driveways or tight yards. You can have our team of two to three people handle the loading, or request a driver-only service and use your own team (Maximum waiting time will apply)

Once loaded, we will transport the container to the destination (coastal shipping, Kiwirail or truck), where a hiab or swinglift lifts it off and sets it down on-site. From there, it can stay put for as long as you need, rather than tying up a truck and driver while it's emptied or used.

How It Works

- Collection: A flatdeck truck arrives at the pickup site. The container stays on the truck while it's loaded, with either our crew or yours doing the work.
- Transport: Once loaded, we transport the container to the delivery address.
- Delivery: A hiab or swinglift lifts the container off the truck and places it on a level, dry area at the destination.
- On-Site Duration: The container remains on-site for as long as required, with no truck or driver tied up while it's there.

Advantages of This Approach

- No lifting equipment needed at the collection end, so it suits narrow or restricted-access sites
- Flexible labour: our team, your team, or driver-only
- The container can stay at the destination indefinitely once placed
- Avoids paying for a truck and driver to wait on-site while the container is in use
